

Football Scholarship Program Overview

Criteria

- Initial interview with child and family.
- Complete CCSC 5 day trial camp.
- Display exemplary behaviour in both academic and sporting sessions.
- Respectful/punctual/organised/committed/team-oriented/strong work ethic.
- Behaviour - student cannot receive a suspension.
- Academic - student submits all work and has not received an 'N' warning.
- "C" student or above
- Ability to be coached - decided by coach when a student is recommended for a scholarship. Determined in the CCSC trial camp.
- CCSC fitness testing - scores are equivalent or greater than national standards.
- Consideration of player's technical, tactical, psychological and social attributes, as well as relative age effect and maturation rates.
- References must be provided.
- Pass a full medical examination with doctors certificate.
- Signed contract to represent CCSC at various sporting events.

Preferences:

- Current NSW Academy Sport Team or previous Member (Age restriction in AOS) or equivalent
- NSW Metro League participant or equivalent
- NSW Premier League participant or equivalent
- Consistent representation in state team competitions.
