
Rugby Union Scholarship Program Overview Criteria

- Initial interview with student and family.
- Display exemplary behaviour in both academic and sports programs.
- Respectful/punctual/organised/committed/team-oriented/strong work ethic.
- Behaviour - Respect of oneself, peers, family and staff.
- Academic - student submits all work and has not received an 'N' warning.
- "C" student or above
- Ability to be coached - Decided by coach when a student is recommended for a scholarship. Determined by observation of training sessions.
- CCSC fitness testing - scores are equivalent to or greater than national standards.
- Selected in either Country Junior, NSW Schools or national representative teams.
- Consistent representation in club games.
- Consideration of player's technical, tactical, psychological and social attributes, as well as relative age effect and maturation rates.
- References must be provided.
- Pass a full medical examination with doctors certificate.
- Signed contract to represent CCSC at various sporting events.
