Principal's Message

We would like to inform families that we have been working with the Department of Education for many months with respect to some concerns from 2014 that the Department raised with us recently. The issue related to the College's acquisition of a tennis club to provide facilities for our students but the continued paid use of those facilities by members of the public breached the Department's definition of being not for profit. The College did not renew the lease on the tennis club in 2016, ending its involvement.

We are committed, as always, to ensuring the College complies with our legislative requirements and welcome the process that we are working through with the Department to ensure the College continues to implement best practice in all aspects of our operations.

We have already completed the independent governance review in 2019 and have implemented, or are in the process of implementing, over half of the recommendations with the balance of recommendations to be implemented by 30 June 2020.
