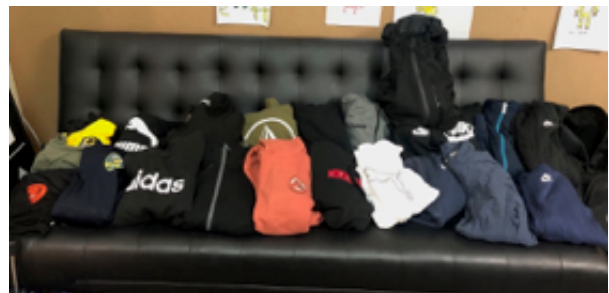
Lost Property

Stage 3 recently visited the Precious Plastics recycling centre we have here on campus. This workshop is part of the EcoSchools Grant the school received in 2018. 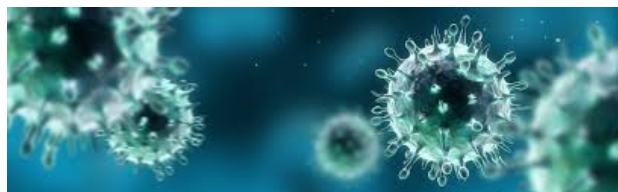
Big Picture Social Action Project
