From The Desk of Paul Chapman (Founder & CEO)



Firstly, I want to thank you for your interest in our school.

As a parent of budding young football players, I have been exposed to club and representative football in the region and I have personally witnessed the strain that having your own children play football can have on a family.

Based on my experience as an educator, I have put together an education and football development program that addresses the needs of your child as a young learner and a young football player. By bringing both education and football development into your child's school day, we will help resolve many of the problems that football families experience on an almost daily basis.

I've spent years watching good football players get passed over for a number of reasons unrelated to their level of skill. Because of this they are denied the kind of coaching that would greatly improve their football skills.

I had a vision to create a school where a child's passion for football could be blended with their academic education so that they would have the best of both worlds. From this was borne the International Football School.

I wanted my school to be an alternative to everything else out there, a place where your child could live their passion and love for football in an environment where they were safe, happy and most of all, respected.

I believe that access to quality training, quality coaches and successful role models are the cornerstones to creating high-class football players. With that in mind I have assembled some of the very best and most successful coaches Australia has to offer.

The IFS offers an unparalleled opportunity for your child to become a stronger and more skilful player and lays the groundwork for a future career in football, if that is the direction in which they want their life to go.

In regard to education, I envisaged placing as much emphasis on academic success as football success.

As an educator I wanted the students in my school to be engaged, energised, motivated and challenged on a daily basis. I undertook extensive research to find a proven method to achieve this. In project based learning (PBL) I have found that. You will learn more about PBL further into this prospectus, however, I am thoroughly convinced about this method and have made it the backbone of the academic program at the IFS.

The learning environment in which a child finds themselves is of vital importance in determining whether or not their full potential is reached.

The IFS will have a learning environment with high academic standards as well as high football standards. However, I believe that in order for your child to achieve their full potential, there also needs to exist a learning environment where your child is happy. This will increase their confidence in their ability to succeed and motivate them to chase success both on the football field and in the classroom.

Success won't come easily at IFS. Your child will be challenged on a daily basis.



They will be encouraged to be the best they can be in rising to challenges. In our supportive and nurturing environment, your child will grow mentally, physically, emotionally and socially.

Your child will have taken their first steps on the path to achieving their full potential in life.

Another part of my vision was to make IFS an alternative to what was already on offer and to make sure that when the time

came students leave IFS to pursue their goals in life, that they were well prepared for success.

With that in mind, I created the IFS Pathways To Success. I will elaborate later in this prospectus as to how these pathways guarantee your child will be ready for the world beyond the International Football School, whether it's a professional football career, a place in university or a career in the workplace.

At IFS, great importance is placed on open, honest, transparent and respectful communication between staff, parents and students. This was the reason for implementing a system to communicate and share information with you that will give you up to date reports and information on the progress of your child.

As a parent of an IFS student you will have access to a private and completely secure online system where you can view up to date information, reports, progress reports, and any other information relevant to your child. I am very excited about this method of communication and feedback.

Before elaborating on this system however, I want to cover bullying and violence; a negative destructive force that has the ability to destroy your child's life if not dealt with in a harsh, decisive and swift manner.

As a parent myself I know this is a vitally important issue.

It is a firmly held belief of the IFS that for your child to achieve their full potential, everything must be in balance. This is why we strive to help your child achieve balance in living, learning and play.

BALANCE IN LIVING

International Football School values balance in your child's life.

Your child will be encouraged to work on, and will receive guidance on personal development, which will help them as individuals, team and family members and global citizens.

Our football and education program will be delivered during the school day so your child can go home and spend time with their family, follow other interests and have time to contribute to their local community.

BALANCE IN PLAY

IFS values balance in our football program.

We endeavour to create a non-competitive development environment that focuses on individual skills and also on learning the benefits of teamwork.

Some of the features of our football program will be-

- Up to 2 hours of football training per day, 5 days a week.
- Full time, professional, coaching staff that will provide individual feedback on a regular and consistent basis.
- Providing pathways for your child into professional football.
- Delivery of Football Federation Australia's (FFA) national curriculum.
- Fulfilment of all appropriate dietary and nutrition needs.

(IFS will be providing all the healthy food needs of your child during the school day.)

As much as football is important, just as important is our students' overall education. We believe that your child must be successful not only on the football field but also in whichever field they choose to pursue when they complete their high school education.

We must prepare them for success.

BALANCE IN LEARNING

IFS will deliver an educational program that covers all key learning areas. Subjects such as English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, Art, Music, Technology, Language and PDHPE will be taught in a project based style to maximise your child's focus, engagement and motivation and ensure authentic and relevant learning opportunities.

Some of the features of our education will be:-

- Delivery of the NSW Board of Studies Curriculum requirements.
- Introduction of the National Curriculum in 2014.
- Innovative project based learning environment.
- Low student to staff ratios.
- Team based learning environment focusing on co-operative learning.
- Focus on individual support as and when required.

THE INTERNATIONAL FOOTBALL SCHOOL EDUCATION PHILOSOPHY

A good question to ask any school you are thinking of sending your child to is what their educational aims are and how they are going to achieve those aims?

Our aim is to provide your child with an education that is full of relevant and authentic learning experiences which are meaningful and which *engage, motivate, excite and challenge them on a daily basis*

The IFS has a team of educators who are able to draw on many years experience working in a variety of different education systems. Based on this wealth of experience we have adopted an innovative and highly effective approach to education. An approach that is ground breaking in Australia.

We believe one of the most important values for any student is respect and allowing some freedom in their learning. By allowing your child to take control of and responsibility for their learning, they will strive to achieve their best and in doing so, achieve their full potential.

Across our entire school curriculum we offer a student-centred, personalised and project-based approach to our teaching and learning which aims to provide consistent stimulation for our students.

Our mission is to prepare your child for life.

Project-based teaching/learning is a dynamic approach to teaching in which your child explores real-world problems and challenges, simultaneously developing cross-curriculum skills while working in small collaborative groups.

Because project-based learning is filled with active and engaged learning, it inspires your child to obtain a deeper knowledge of the subjects they're studying.

Research also indicates that students are more likely to retain the knowledge gained through this approach than through traditional textbook-centered learning. In addition, they develop confidence and self-direction as they move through both team-based and independent work.

In the process of completing their projects, students also hone their organisational and research skills, develop better communication with their peers and adults, and often work within their community getting a chance to see the positive effect of their work.

Because your child is evaluated based on their projects, assessment of project-based work is often more meaningful to them. They quickly see how their academic work can connect to real-life issues -- and may even be inspired to pursue a career that relates to the project they developed.

Students will thrive on the greater flexibility of project learning. In addition to participating in traditional assessment, they might also be evaluated on:

- Presentations they have prepared for a community audience.

OR

- An informative tour of a local historical site based on their recently acquired knowledge.

OR

- Screening of a scripted film they have produced.

Project learning is also an effective way to integrate technology into the curriculum. A typical project can easily accommodate computers and the internet, digital cameras, video cameras, and associated editing equipment.

The IFS project-learning approach will invigorate your child's environment, energizing learning with a real-world relevance and sparking their desire to explore, investigate, and understand their world.

This means your child will participate in projects which are authentic and draw on skills from multiple subject areas.

No longer will subject areas be separated with teachers working in isolation. Our teachers will collaborate to ensure that students gain a deep understanding of important concepts and content that has real world applications.

Students will have the opportunity to plan and sequence their learning program based on their needs with individual one-on-one guidance from our teachers, on a frequent basis.

In this atmosphere of trust, sharing, collaboration and guidance, we know your child's learning will flourish.

HOMework

With balance in your child's life being a priority, the IFS has a no homework policy.

We are doing this for two reasons:

1. We believe that our project-based learning approach allows students to engage fully and work effectively toward their education goals during school hours, thus eliminating the need for homework.
2. We believe that school time is for learning and home time is for spending with family, participating in other interests, spending time with friends, helping in the community and growing on a social level outside of the school environment.

Years Five and Six

In years five and six, your child is emerging as an independent learner in a teacher-guided learning environment, during which time they will experience an extensive range of exciting learning experiences across all the key learning areas.

In year five they will move through a range of age appropriate lessons. They will feel comfortable in a classroom that encourages meaningful learning pursuits.

In year six the blending of teacher-guided and self-directed learning grows and your child builds the skills needed for later project-based learning.

Years Seven to Ten

In year seven through to ten the teaching and learning approach, used by the IFS is designed around Project Based Learning (PBL) and Service Learning Programs (SLP).

Your child will learn syllabus content, gain leadership skills and importantly, an awareness of community needs.

This teaching and learning approach provides:

- * Authentic projects
- * Inquiry Based Discovery
- * Self Directed Learning
- * Collaborative Activities
- * Team Teaching
- * Use of Technology
- * Self- Regulation
- * Presentations

Years Eleven (2014) to Twelve (2015)

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) PROGRAM

I believe IFS provides an alternative to what is already available in the marketplace with our project-based approach to education and through having football development as part of the school day.

Going a step further however, in years eleven and twelve the IFS is considering offering the International Baccalaureate (IB) Program as an alternative to the HSC. The reasons for this are;

- We believe that the IB Program is a more rigorous framework than the HSC.
- The IB Program is a globally recognised and praised program.
- The IB Program fits perfectly into the IFS goals and values for your child, as expressed in this extract from its mission statement

The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

21st CENTURY LEARNING

Our teaching approach makes learning exciting and engaging for your child.

It's about connecting your child to the world, giving them a sense of what it is to be a global citizen and most importantly, making what they learn relevant now and for the future.

Your child will be empowered to develop their critical thinking and communication skills, as well as their ability to work collaboratively.

Each project offered to our students has a focus key learning area, with a cross-curricular blending of learning components over a wide range of subjects.

Your child is presented with an issue, topic or task on which they must work both collaboratively and individually to create a finished project.

The projects meet the NSW Board of Studies Curriculum requirements and when implemented, the Australian National Curriculum.

The IFS recognises the importance of Creative Arts in education. Students will be provided with a variety of Creative Art experiences to enhance their overall learning at IFS.

All High School students will be expected to participate in a key stage production.

We know that social media is a huge element in today's society. At IFS students will be taught the correct etiquette to interact with people on social media sites including Facebook and Twitter.

We also recognise that being bilingual is a vital foundation for your child's future success. Recognising its importance, all students will learn an Asian language.

The IFS language program supports current research into the benefits of studying a second language which include:

- Assisting academic progress in other subjects.
- Aiding higher order, abstract and creative thinking.
- Building a sense of achievement.
- Promoting cultural awareness and understanding.
- Increasing career opportunities.

CREATING HIGHLY EFFECTIVE PEOPLE

The IFS will be implementing the principles that Dr. Stephen Covey considers all highly effective people share.

This means students will work first and foremost on how to be a better person, how to work well with others and then how to take time to reflect and think about the next steps to self-improvement.

We urge parents to read Dr. Covey's book **"The 7 Habits Of Highly Effective People"** .



FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT & TRAINING PHILOSOPHY

Our aim for the football program is simple:

To turn your child from a player who just plays football...into a player who plays *beautiful football*

Development, development, development is our core focus.

We will be adopting Football Federation Australia's National Curriculum and ensuring that your child has every opportunity for selection in representative teams and to follow other elite football pathways, where appropriate.

We aim to develop your child into a technically masterful player who is creative, imaginative and passionate.

Our focus is on developing players who have a love for the game and aspire to be the best they can be. By focusing on the technical aspects of individual skills your child will be mentored into becoming part of a bigger unit and learn how working together as a team can produce great results.

A significant focus throughout our program will be to ensure your child becomes a master of the ball. Players who can move throughout the game without fear of losing the ball will play the game with a heightened level of confidence.

As your child develops ball mastery, the next phase is to understand that the whole team can achieve more than any one individual. Your child's confidence in not only themselves but their team mates is fundamental to building a great footballer and will be a major focus of our philosophy at IFS.



Long Term Development Versus Short Term Glory

IFS does not intend to enter into long term competitions (unless the competition focus is about development) as we believe it is more important in the formative years (from 8 – 14 or slightly older) for the focus to be on developing as a player.

Long term competitions with ladders and points on a table is an easy way to lose sight of how to play the best football, as the temptation and pressure to win can cloud focus on development.

We believe that the wins will come, and keep coming on a consistent basis when, and only when, the skills are mastered.

We don't think competition is wrong, it just means we will choose the types of competitions to participate in. By choosing development competitions, playing against the best there is in Australia, and thereby only exposing your child to elite players, your child will become the best they can be.

A few of the elite teams IFS will be playing against are from the following academies:

- Mongo Football
- AC Milan
- AS Roma
- 1st Eleven
- Red Devils
- AESFA
- Brazilian Soccer
- Soccer De Brazil

We will also be entering into competitions against elite SAP teams and similar.

Our program focuses on the long-term development of players.

After working through the IFS program over a number of years we believe if your child is focused and has the intention and will to succeed, they will turn into the very best footballers they can be.

An organization is only as good as the people in it, and with this in mind IFS has employed some of the best people in football development and training.

Julie Dolan (Football Technical Director)



Julie Dolan is nothing short of Australian football royalty.

In 1988, to honour her achievements and service to Australian football, the Australian Women's Soccer Association, created the *Julie Dolan Medal*.

The Medal is awarded annually to the player voted to be the best in the Australian Women's Football League.

Julie captained the Australian women's national football team on 6 different

occasions while playing 18 international games.

She is an inductee to the FFA Football Hall of Fame and a nominee for the title of "Greatest Ever Australian Footballer".

Julie is the driving force behind every IFS football program.

Joey Peters (Senior Coach)



Hailed as one of the greatest female midfielders to ever play the game, Joey Peters is a football tour de force. Recently Joey had the position of assistant coach at the Newcastle Jets W-League team.

For 13 years, between 1996 and 2009 she played as a member of the Matildas[®], the Australian women's national football team, and was capped 109 times scoring a total of 28 goals for her country.

During her career, she played in no less than 4 World Cups 1999, 2003, 2004 and 2007.

Joey is also a nominee for the title of "Greatest Ever Australian Footballer".

IFS is proud to have Joey as its Senior Coach, working closely with Julie Dolan to create the best football training and youth development programs in Australia.



Brad Porter



Brad Porter is a much beloved football player on the Central Coast. He's a former Central Coast Mariners player.

He first came to the Mariners late in the 2005-06 A-League season and appeared again in the yellow and blue for the 2006-07 campaign.

During his tenure at the Mariners Brad played against quality opposition such as Melbourne Victory FC and Adelaide United FC, and quickly impressed the other players with his versatility, strength and skill.

He was so highly thought of by the Mariners' coach that for the 2007-08 A-league season, he made it very clear the Mariners would be holding on to Brad, and that he would be a major part of that season's campaign.

On the 11th of July 2012, Brad announced his retirement from professional football. He then spoke of his excitement at starting the new phase of his football career, as coach with the International Football School.

Professional Football Success Pathway

If your child wants to progress to professional footballer status at the end of their time with us, or even during their time with us, we have an effective pathway established to facilitate this opportunity.

The IFS pathways consist of our relationships with professional football clubs all over Australia and worldwide, including English Premier League teams.

These relationships include:

- Constant communication with professional clubs worldwide.
- Visits to IFS by professional club scouts.
- Presentations by professional players outlining the life and commitments of professional football players.
- Presentations by professional club officials, outlining what they look for in a new player signing and how to be successful at their particular club.
- Regular updates on your child from IFS to all professional clubs in our network.

Our football curriculum and the IFS elite coaches will make sure that your child has an equal opportunity to maximise their ability and pursue the dream of becoming a professional player.

University Success Pathway

While we are aware that your child will love and have a great passion for “the beautiful game”, we also understand that they may not want to pursue a professional soccer career. In other sporting and educational organizations your child would be left to find their own way.

At IFS, if your child is one of those students who doesn't wish to pursue football as a career, we offer very effective and successful pathways to higher-level education in Australia and worldwide.

These pathways include:

- Inviting university officials and academics to IFS to give lectures on issues of interest.
- Making sure that IFS has up-to-date news regarding requirements for selection by universities.
- Constant communication with all universities with updates about your child.
- Information directly from officials and professors about what they expect from their students and how to gain entry to their chosen university.
- Trips with IFS to Universities.
- Presentations to IFS students by current and past students of universities explaining the many sides of university life.
- Your child being coached on the application process for each university.
- Your child being given help choosing the best university for their talents and strengths and their chosen career path
- Information from experts and universities on the best way to secure scholarships to universities in order to reduce financial burden on you...the parents.



Business Success Pathway

If your child wants to get into the workplace after completing their schooling at IFS they will be given the tools needed to not only succeed in gaining full time employment but also the tools needed to be a success in their employment.

To facilitate this, IFS has strong and beneficial relationships with businesses, companies and registered training organisations at local, state and national levels and we will be:

- Inviting business owners to IFS to tell the students what they are looking for in new employees.

- Arranging meaningful work experience for your child in the industry of their choice.
- Arranging for business owners/ managers to come to IFS and “scout” for employees for their companies.

- taught interview skills and partake in interview role-plays so that they are used to the pressure of a job interview.
- taught the most effective way to answer interview questions and how to put their best foot forward in an interview.
- shown the best places to search for jobs and the most effective methods of approaching companies.
- taught career management skills that will help them advance their career over their working life.

SO WHAT NOW?

If you decide to enrol your child with the International Football School, please fill out our online registration form. We will send you an email confirming your registration on our waiting list.

Please Note: *A \$50 registration fee applies to ensure your child's place on the waiting list is guaranteed.*

(Registrations submitted prior to our formal NSW Board of Studies approval will have the \$50 registration fee waived.)

Students on our waiting list may be invited to apply for enrolment in our school based on their date of registration on our list.

You will then be emailed or posted a more detailed enrolment form that you need to complete.

You will need to submit:

- **A current photo**
- **School reports for the previous 12 months**
- **A copy of your child's birth certificate**

You and your child will be invited to attend an interview. This is an important part of the enrolment process and will complete the final step prior to acceptance to our school.

Your child will spend some time with one of our teaching staff and we encourage you to ask any questions.

Following the interview, an offer of placement at International Football School may be made.

If your child is accepted as a student, the letter of offer will outline the things you need to do to accept the offer.
